Monday, March 23, 2020 Washington Gov. Jay Inslee ordered all residents except essential workers to stay at home for at least two weeks. As designated by according to the Department of Defense and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, the work and position of this individual is deemed as an essential worker to an essential business:

- Employees engaged in the manufacture and maintenance of equipment and other infrastructure necessary to agricultural production and distribution.
- Workers who provide support to vulnerable populations to ensure their health and well-being including family care providers.
- Workers who support food, shelter, and social services, and other necessities of life for economically disadvantaged or otherwise needy individuals, such as those residing in shelters.
- Workers who provide or determine eligibility for food, shelter, in-home supportive services, child welfare, adult protective services and social services, and other necessities of life for economically disadvantaged or otherwise needy individuals (including family members and individuals experiencing homelessness.)

Employees in possession of this notice are considered to be mission critical and essential. Please take note of the attached documentation for Nelson Irrigation Corporation and the United States Department of Defense.
